Once it's gone, it's gone!

NIBBLES AND DRINKS

After listening to our attendees and reviewing your responses in the 2025 feedback survey, we've decided to adjust our policy on bringing food, nibbles, and drinks into the venue. From #HF26 onwards, you are welcome to bring certain items with you – as long as they are sealed in their original packaging and unopened on arrival. Here's what you can bring:

- **Crisps**
- **Chocolate bars and sweets**
- **Whole fruit (e.g. apples, bananas, oranges)**
- **Baby food in sealed pouches (plastic no glass jars)**
- **Juice boxes/cartons**
- **Bottled water, milk cartons and fruit flavoured drinks (which must be sealed and under 500 ml – no cans or glass. Plastic bottles only, no metal thermal cups)**

- **Cereal bars/Protein bars**
- **Dried fruit packs**
- **Yogurt tubes/pots**
- **Trail mix/nuts**
- **Kids' Cheese and crackers**

All items must remain sealed until you arrive at the festival gates. If you require specific food/drink for medical reasons, you will need to provide us with written medical evidence by email or a doctor's certificate on the day.

*Please note, our security team and volunteers have the final discretion on which food and drink items may be permitted into the festival arena.

GATES OPEN

The gates will open from 3.30 pm on Friday and 11 am on Saturday and Sunday to enter the festival. We recommend you arrive a little earlier to avoid unnecessary queuing. We are expecting a large crowd, and have put measures in place to get you in quickly and safely.

LAST ENTRY

The last entry to the festival across all three days is at 6 pm. Please factor this in when travelling to the festival.

DRUGS POLICY

We have a zero-tolerance policy on the use of drugs. If found, you will be escorted away from the festival and denied re-entry.

DISABLED VIEWING

To the side of the main stage, there is a dedicated disabled viewing area adjacent to disabled toilets and baby changing facilities.

TICKET QUERIES

If you have any questions about your tickets, please ensure you go to the Box Office upon arrival. This is located next to the festival entrance on Ferry Road.

RE-ENTRY

You can come and go across the weekend as you please. If you wish to leave, you will be given a token to keep safe and return when you come back to the festival site.

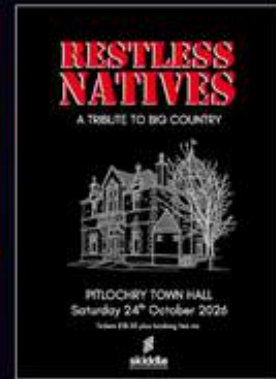

DOGS

We love dogs, but only the well-behaved ones!! Dogs are very welcome, but they must be kept on leads at all times and away from the food vendors and children's area. Please also clean up after your dog.

WEATHER

In the event of bad weather, please be mindful that the festival is being held on the Recreation Ground, which is a grassed area and, therefore, subject to muddy conditions.

VOLUNTEERS

We have an amazing and super helpful team of volunteers at the festival. If you need any help, please ask one of them.

SECURITY

Bag searches are mandatory as part of our entertainment licence and are likely to be accompanied by random pat-downs, similar to those at airports.

CASH AND CARDS

Each of our vendors will be accepting card payments. This is our preferred method of payment; however, payment systems can be interrupted from time to time, so it is advisable to bring some cash with you for the weekend.

WHEN LEAVING

Please be respectful to our local residents and keep the noise to a minimum. Thank you!

FIRST AID

If anyone requires first aid, please advise a volunteer or a member of our security staff. Our paramedics can be located at the main entrance to the ground below the control centre.

RUBBISH

There are ample facilities for disposing of your rubbish. Please help our amazing team of volunteers by placing any rubbish in the bins provided.

LITTLE HEARTLANDERS

We have a dedicated area for the little ones at Heartland. This can be found near the main entrance, close to the Ferris Wheel.

SHUTTLE BUSES

If you are travelling to and from the festival using the shuttle buses, please note that the drop-off and pick-up locations are in the town centre of Pitlochry, not at the festival grounds.

FESTIVAL MERCH

Festival merch will be available to buy over the weekend. Stock will be limited, so we recommend you get in quick to get your Heartland merch for 2026.

GETTING HERE

BY PLANE

Glasgow and Edinburgh are the closest major airports to Pitlochry, with Inverness airport in the north.

BY TRAIN

Take a leisurely journey through the Scottish countryside. Trains from all the major cities stop regularly at Pitlochry Station, and the Festival is just a short walk away. For train times and prices, download the Trainline app to book your journey in just a few taps.

BY BUS

Citylink, Flixbus, Stagecoach, Megabus and Ember all have routes into Pitlochry. Please visit their website to find the best route and times for you.

BY CAR

Pitlochry is just off the A9, Scotland's main north/south thoroughfare, and just a 1hr 40mins drive from Glasgow, Edinburgh and Inverness. Click the link for a detailed map, or enter PH16 5DD in your satnav. Always plan ahead and check Traffic Scotland for current travel conditions.

Please note that there is no on-site parking at the festival unless Blue Badge parking has already been booked with us.

Ensure you are fit to drive. Driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol is dangerous and illegal. Consider when you last had a drink. There will be a heightened police presence around the site during the festival. Don't take any risks—wait until you are certain you are safe to drive. It's the sensible choice.

IMPORTANT

TRAVELLING TO HEARTLAND

As you travel to Heartland Festival, please be aware that the ongoing A9 Dualling works between Dunkeld and Ballinluig remain an active construction site. Whilst every effort is being made to minimise disruption, road users may experience delays due to reduced speed limits and traffic management measures, particularly during busy periods.

To help make your journey as smooth as possible, we recommend:

- **Leaving plenty of time for your journey**
- **Planning your route before travelling**
- **Checking traffic updates before setting off**
- **Considering our Park & Ride service to avoid parking congestion in and around Pitlochry**
- **Allowing extra time if travelling during peak arrival and departure periods**

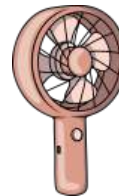
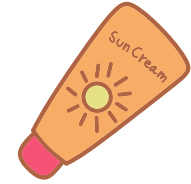
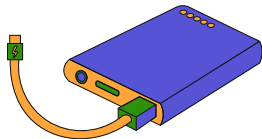
We want your Heartland experience to get off to the best possible start, so please travel safely and plan ahead where possible.

- Wet Wipes
- Outdoor blanket
- Portable phone charger
- Mini fan
- Folding chair
- Small umbrella



THINGS NOT TO BRING

- Your own alcohol
- Soft drinks
- Food
- Any glass containers
- Potential harmful fluids (for example, paint stripper)
- Weapons – bladed or pointed
- Large Umbrellas
- Flags or banners
- Marker pens
- Laser pens
- Non-prescription drugs, including the previously described ‘legal highs’
- Professional photography or recording equipment, sound systems, unless authorised by Heartland Festival Ltd
- Chinese lanterns, Fireworks/Flares/Laser candle lights/Gas canisters/BBQ’s
- Sparklers
- Any other type of explosive
- Windbreaker/tents/gazebos
- Bicycles
- Aerosols or gas canisters
- Air horns, klaxons, megaphones, drums or any similar items
- Laser Lights and Drones
- Any personalised motorised vehicle (but mobility vehicles and wheelchairs are allowed);
- Any radio communicators
- Personal generators
- Leisure batteries or vehicle batteries (lithium-ion “power bank” batteries with the “CE” mark are permitted)
- Barbecues of any sort, camping stoves of any sort or any other heat-producing cooking equipment
- You must not smoke in any enclosed spaces or in other areas where signs indicate they are non-smoking. This includes e-cigarettes (and similar things).
